## **Exhibitor Information**

### **Set-Up:**

**The show is open to the public 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.** Set-up Saturday, May 1, 2010 beginning at 8 a.m. Please enter the WheatonArts grounds through the left front gate in the entrance. When you check in, you will be given a packet of information and your show badges, and will be directed to your exhibit space. You may drive to your space to unload, but please be considerate of others. There are many convenient areas within the grounds where you may leave your vehicle during set up. All vehicles must be off the grounds and set up must be completed by 9:45 a.m.

### **Exhibits:**

The show is held rain or shine. Please bring a canopy or tent for your booth if possible.

Booths will be pre-assigned. Your location assignment will be sent to you prior to the event. Exhibit areas are located on wooded grounds, so you should be prepared to adjust to any uneven surfaces.

Booth sizes are assumed to be 12 ft wide X 10 ft deep. Please inform us if you need additional space for your booth. We can easily adjust if we know your needs in advance.

If you need tables, Please order them on the registration form. Since we must rent the tables from an outside source, we do not have additional ones available at the last minute. Two chairs per booth space will be provided at no charge.

You are responsible for all other exhibit materials and supplies. All unsightly packaging and storage should be hidden out of sight.

Electrical service will be provided only if requested on registration form. If you have requested electric, bring with you a heavy duty outdoor extension cord at least 20 ft. long.

### **Show Parking::**

Please park your vehicle in the designated lot on Glasstown Road. We ask that you do not park in the main circle or in the employee lot, in order to allow parking space for our visitors and staff.

### **Breakdown Information:**

Breakdown may not begin until 5 p.m.

**No vehicles will be permitted to return to the grounds until visitors have exited .**

### **NO PETS:**

Due to insurance regulations, no pet animals are permitted on WheatonArts grounds. Assistance animals are welcome.
