| <u>Set-up:</u> | Exhibitors may begin set-up Friday at 11:00 a.m. and must be finished by 4 p.m. The Event Center is under heavy electronic security through the night. However, if you choose, you may remove your exhibits from the building Friday after 8 p.m. and bring them back Saturday morning.
