WATCH World Class Art Created in the Glass Studio

You'll see hot molten glass transformed into beautiful paperweights, vases, pitchers and abstract contemporary sculpture during our special, narrated demonstrations in the Glass Studio. The experience will connect your group to a regional art, a cornerstone of New Jersey's cultural history.

ENJOY Artist Demonstrations in the Studios

Ceramic Studio – Get up close as the artist explains and demonstrates the transformation of cold, wet clay into shapely vessels.

Flameworking Studio - Learn the art of making glass objects (marbles, beads, icicles and other small works) from glass rods. The artist manipulates rods of glass over a torch and explains the difference between this method of glassmaking and that which is seen in the Glass Studio.

Woodcarving Studio - Our woodcarver's styles range from folk carvings of Noah's Ark to finely detailed bird carvings.
