Who: Wheaton Arts and Cultural Center, in conjunction with the Cumberland County SPCA hosts PAWS for Art each year in April.

Additional information: The Cumberland County SPCA will provide volunteers as dog sitters on Sunday, April 10, 2016 so dog owners may visit the Museum of American Glass and the Museum Stores. Dogs will be allowed in the Artists' Studios. For pet safety all dogs will be required to be on a short, no longer than four feet lead. No retractable leashes. Water stations will be located throughout the grounds.
